Across all of 2024, Africa imported just under 3.7 GW of panels from China--a sharp rise from 2023. By May 2025 alone, the continent had already added nearly half that figure in a single ...

In 2024, China produced 80% of the world's solar panels and remains by far the largest exporter. Africa's dependence on imports is heavy because local manufacturing capacity is still minimal.

For now, Africa remains almost entirely reliant on foreign suppliers. China accounts for 85-90% of installations, and dominance extends well beyond panels to batteries, inverters and ...

From Algeria on the Mediterranean coast to landlocked Zambia in the south, countries across Africa have been importing significantly more solar panels from China this year than in the...

Imports from China may account for the bulk of solar sold in Africa, but the report also highlights growth in PV manufacturing capacity across the continent.
