Why did Eni build two power plants in Congo Brazzaville?

Eni, the leading natural gas producer in Congo Brazzaville, constructed the two natural gas-fired power plants to reduce natural gas flaring and commercialize more of the associated natural gas produced at its oil fields.

Does Congo Brazzaville have natural gas?

Most of Congo Brazzaville's hydrocarbons production is located offshore. Congo Brazzaville holds sizable proved natural gas reserves, but only a small portion of the reserves is commercialized because of a lack of natural gas infrastructure.

Does Congo Brazzaville have hydropower?

Hydropower accounted for 25% Congo Brazzaville's total installed electricity capacity in 2021. As of early 2024, the country had three hydropower plants. Congo Brazzaville has significant hydropower potential, estimated at 3.9 GW, but only 5% of this power has been developed.

Congo Brazzaville, also known as the Republic of Congo or the 'Other Congo', is a country located near Kinshasa. It might not be as illustrious as the Democratic Republic of Congo, but it has a lot to offer and makes for a perfect follow-up to our DRC Tour.
