

Do photovoltaic panels need to be covered with tarpaulin when transporting

Should you put a tarp over solar panels during a storm? Learn safe protection methods and better alternatives to shield your solar investment.

For the vast majority of people that own solar panels, it's highly likely that you will NEVER need to cover your solar panels...really just during transport if you happen to move or store them for some reason.

Cover the panels with a tarp or other protective covering when they're not in use. This will safeguard them from hail, wind, and other weather conditions that could cause damage.

You don't need to be a professional to throw a tarp over your solar panels. Just make sure you secure it properly with some ropes or bungee cords, and you're good to go.

My thought was to buy at least a cover for the solar panels to make it easy to take off and put back on when needed. I've been looking on Amazon for a tarp with elastic edges to easily pull on and off but ...

In the case of DIY installations, a thick tarp or even blankets can be used to cover the panels and prevent them from absorbing energy while the panels are being installed.
