

# How to produce methanol with solar power

Can solar energy produce methanol from carbon dioxide and water?

We describe a novel solar-based process for the production of methanol from carbon dioxide and water. The system utilizes concentrated solar energy in a thermochemical reactor to reenergize CO<sub>2</sub> into CO and then water gas shift (WGS) to produce syngas (a mixture of CO and H<sub>2</sub>) to feed a methanol synthesis reactor.

How much electricity does a methanol plant use?

The electricity consumption for electrolysis process is still in the range between 4.5 and 7.5 kW h/N m<sup>3</sup>. In the methanol plant, electricity is required for the precompression of two gases (CO<sub>2</sub> and H<sub>2</sub>) and the compression of recycle feed integrated with sulfur recovery unit (SRU) system.

Does methanol plant need electricity to convert CO<sub>2</sub> and H<sub>2</sub>?
