You will likely never need to replace your Base Station"s batteries as they are rechargeable and meant to last. The Base Station takes four (4) 1.2V, 1300mAh nickel-metal hydride (NiMH) rechargeable ...

To replace the batteries in your Base Station, first unscrew the battery cover on the back of the unit. Then, remove the old batteries and insert new ones in their place.

Replacing The Base Station Batteries Once you have acquired the necessary Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) rechargeable batteries, you can follow the steps below to replace them:
