



Is it safe to be inside a communication base station during a thunderstorm

If the sky looks threatening or if you hear thunder, get inside a safe place immediately. Once inside, avoid contact with corded phones, electrical equipment, plumbing, and windows and doors.

Many lightning victims are caught outside during a storm because they did not act promptly to get to a safe place, or they go back outside too soon after a storm has passed. Lightning ...

If inside during a thunderstorm, do the following: Stay off corded phones. Cell phones and cordless phones are okay. Do NOT use anything connected to an electrical outlet, such as ...

Stay in safe shelter at least 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder. Stay off corded phones, computers and other electrical equipment. Avoid plumbing, including sinks, baths and ...

When inside the cabin during a lightning storm, stay away from all metal and electrical components, including the radio, unless it is an emergency. If caught in a storm in a small boat with ...

To stay safe during thunderstorms, it's advisable to avoid using phones altogether and seek shelter indoors until the storm passes.

Proper planning and safe practices can easily increase lightning safety when working outdoors. When thunder roars, go indoors! If you hear thunder, even a distant rumble, get to a safe place ...
