

Solar system stars names

IAU approval comes mostly from its Working Group on Star Names, which has been publishing a "List of IAU-approved Star Names" since 2016. As of April 2022, the list included a total of 451 proper names ...

Each of those stars has a proper name: Dubhe, Merak, Phecda, Megrez, Alioth, Mizar, and Alkaid. But there are a lot of stars in the sky, almost 10,000 stars are visible to the naked-eye!
