Do I need to inform my neighbors before installing solar panels?

There is generally no need to inform your neighbors before installing solar panels. You don't need to inform them since solar panels are designed to minimize reflection. Even if your neighbor is looking directly at your solar panels, it's unlikely to affect them significantly.
